my family up to date with my Father.


I understand you only include those who are deceased.

David Morier Evans b 13th June 1819 d 1st January 1874.

Baptized 13 June 1819 St Andrew Holborn London.

Father Joshua Lloyd Evans bc 1782.

Mother Harriett Thomason Stanton Morier b 7th September 1764
d 15th July 1832.

Married Jemima Swan c 1840 she was bc 1816 d 19th February 1894.

David Morier is buried in Abney Park Cemetery Stoke Newington London as is his Wife Jemima and two daughters Louise Emily Hassell and Martha Johnstone, Louise being the first to be buried in the grave as she was only 20 years old and it was then kept as a family grave.

David Morier (Senior) was a financial journalist working in the City of London and writing many books that are still in print today.

Arthur Henry Evans b 7th October 1852 d 12th May 1891.


Son of David Morier Evans senior he purchased The Vanity Fair Magazine in 1887 from Thomas Gibson Bowles for what then must have seemed a huge amount of £20,000.

Arthur Henry Evans joined up with George Witherby as owner and editor respectively, Evans had been the former City Editor for Bowles and reportedly used the pearch mainly to manipulate the stock in which he was interested.

Bowles did not abandon all journalistic interests. He had launched "The Lady" Magazine in 1885 and his putative mistress his childrens governess Rita Shell took over editorship in 1895 with continuing success.
