YOU declare that you shall from henceforth hold with our Sovereign Lord the King's Majesty that now is, and with His Heirs and Successors, Kings and Queens of *Great Britain*, against all persons to live and to die; and maintain the Peace, and all the Franchises of this City of *Newcastle upon Tyne*, and be obedient to the LORD MAYOR, ALDERMEN, SHERIFF, and all other the Officers of the same, and their Council keep; and no Man's goods avow for yours unless he be as free as yourself, and of the same Franchise: And you shall observe and keep to the best of your Power, all lawful Ordinances made by Common Consent, on High Court days; and all other Things you shall do that belong to a FREEMAN of the said City.
